

Matthew Bason's career as a performer began in 1994 at a variety of venues as pianist and organist. First appearing in a solo recital at Hadlow Down East Sussex. He was both working and a student of Reading University. Mathew graduated with a B.A. (Ed) Honours degree in Music and Education in 2002.

His reputation has become international; with performances in mainland Europe, U.S.A., and Canada. At other times Mathew is teaching and performing across the U.K. In September 2015, Matthew joined a team of organists at 'The Scarborough Fair Collection'; there he entertains visitors to the museum collection on the Wurlitzer organ.
