He was both working and a student at Reading University. Mathew graduated with a B.A. (Ed) Honours degree in Music and Education in 2002.

His reputation has become international; with performances in mainland Europe, U.S.A., and Canada. At other times Mathew is teaching and performing across the U.K. In September 2015, Matthew joined a team of organists at 'The Scarborough Fair Collection'; there he entertains visitors to the museum collection on the Wurlitzer organ.

Beside his organ music, Matthew is pianist in the jazz quartet "Jazz Essence" and jazz band "Lula Jazz". He is also the Organist of St. Andrew's Anglican Church, Wellingborough.
